THE LORD’S SUPPER

Today we observe the sacrament of the Lord’s Supper. To the Lord’s Table are invited all who are communicant members in good standing at any evangelical church, who trust in Christ alone for salvation, and who are seeking to live for the Lord according to the Scriptures.

Larger Catechism Question # 174 - What is required of them that receive the sacrament of the Lord’s supper in the time of the administration of it?

It is required of them that receive the sacrament of the Lord’s supper, that, during the time of the administration of it, with all holy reverence and attention they wait upon God in that ordinance, diligently observe the sacramental elements and actions, heedfully discern the Lord’s body, and affectionately meditate on his death and suffering, and thereby stir up themselves to a vigorous exercise of their graces; in judging themselves, and sorrowing for sin; in earnest hungering and thirsting after Christ, feeding on him by faith, receiving of his fullness, trusting in his merits, rejoicing in his love, giving thanks for his grace; in renewing of their covenant with God, and love to all the saints.
