World Witness Prayer Update

An update from the refugee trip taken by Alex Pettett, Executive Director for World Witness, and other World Witness Missionaries. Our purpose was to better understand the global refugee crisis and hear firsthand accounts from refugees and church leaders. We began in southeast Turkey, where many refugees first arrive. Then we traveled to Izmir, Turkey, and finally visited Berlin, Germany which is the goal for many refugees. We were struck by the depth of suffering and hearing their stories made us realize the situation is worse than we have seen on the news. But we also walked away with new hope. God has placed His people at each of these key locations to show His love and mercy. We heard not only stories of trauma and despair but of hope that comes from the Gospel. Thank you for your prayers and sacrifice that allow trips like these for the glory and expansion of His kingdom.
