World Witness Prayer Update

An update from the van Dalen's, missionaries in Lithuania that we support with World Witness. We have a special prayer request: In just over a week's time we will be attending and leading the Bible Study times at the Annual Children's Camp of the Evangelical Reformed Synod in Lithuania. Over 105 children have already signed up and more are expected. Although most of them are from Reformed families and background, most do not attend church regularly and almost all of them have little or no Bible knowledge. This is a true mission-field. We will be teaching from parables in the Gospel of Mark. Every child will be given a Gospel. Our illustrations will come from Pilgrim's Progress. Every group leader has been given a copy. Our goal is simple: over six days, to introduce the children (and their group leaders!) to the Gospel. Please pray for the work of the Holy Spirit and His Word in these young hearts...and for our strength and endurance.
