World Witness Prayer Update

An update from the Cochran's, missionaries we support with World Witness. We initially agreed to go to Spain because of our desire to serve where needed and plant churches, and the field has grown tremendously since we joined World Witness three years ago. We are encouraged that World Witness now has 6 families serving in Spain, and the Lord has been showing us that we can be better used on a different field with greater personnel needs.

Through much prayer and discussion, we both came to the conclusion that [God] was, in fact, leading us to approach World Witness about where we could be used most efficiently. That led us to consider Wales, where World Witness has one full-time missionary family working to see the church grow. It became clear that there was much work to be done in Wales and in the United Kingdom, and that we could be an asset to the work there. We...believe that the Holy Spirit is directing us there, and so we are excited to see where the Lord leads us on this adventure! We are so thankful for you and Crowder's Creek and your support of us.
