## HISTORICAL COMMITTEE

The Session has chosen to re-establish the Historical Committee for Crowders Creek Church. The goals of the committee are to identify and preserve documents, pictures and items that relate to the organization and growth of our church facilities and Congregation and to document how God has worked within and through this church in the past and present.

In order to do this, we need some help. Among other things, persons are needed to help document current and future events in our church's life by way of photos and reports. The records and documents that we currently have in storage need to be reviewed, organized and prepared for future storage.
